#### **Text Books**

Ararat College has endeavoured to create an all inclusive approach to resources and equipment. For this reason, as a general rule, students are not required to source or buy their text books and they are loaned to students as required.

## **Educational items for students to own**

## • Stationery and Optional Items

All students will need to supply their own stationery and may require other optional items listed. These can be purchased through Office National Ararat via an online ordering portal that has been set up. Details on ordering are on page 4 and 5.

#### Laptops

All students require access to a laptop and students have the option to borrow a device from the library, purchase a new one or bring their own.

Laptops can be purchased from 'Learning With Technologies' (LWT) through an online portal where parents may purchase their own device if they wish. Laptops offered here meet all the specifications required for school use. Please read these details carefully (pages 6 and 7) before making a decision.

#### Calculators

**CASIO FX-8200AU** - This is the preferred model if you need to purchase a new calculator. It will cover all maths subjects from Years 7-10, including VCE Chemistry and Physics. The calculator can be purchased as part of the booklists on pages 4 and 5.

**CASIO ClassPad fx-CP400** - Students in Years 11 and 12 who have selected General Maths or Maths Methods will need to have access to a Casio ClassPad calculator. Ararat College has ClassPad calculators available to loan students for these subjects, but many students elect to purchase their own. Details on how to order are on page 8.

#### **FREE INSTRUCTION**

- Schools provide students with free instruction and ensure students have free access to all items, activities and services that are used by the school to fulfil the requirements of the Curriculum. This includes the Victorian Curriculum F-10, the Victorian Certificate of Education (VCE) including the VCE Vocational Major and the Victorian Pathways Certificate.
- Schools may invite parents to make a financial contribution to support the school.

## PARENT PAYMENT REQUESTS

Schools can request contributions from parents under three categories:



#### **Curriculum Contributions**

Voluntary financial contributions for curriculum items and activities which the school deems necessary for students to learn the Curriculum.

#### **Other Contributions**

Voluntary financial contributions for non-curriculum items and activities that relate to the school's functions and objectives.

# Extra-Curricular Items and Activities

Items and activities that enhance or broaden the schooling experience of students and are above and beyond what the school provides for free to deliver the Curriculum. These are provided on a user-pays basis.

Schools may also invite parents to supply or purchase educational items to use and own (e.g. textbooks, stationery, digital devices).



#### FINANCIAL HELP FOR FAMILIES

## Laptops

#### What are my options?

#### Please read these details carefully before making a decision.

All students require access to a laptop and students have the option to borrow a device from the library, purchase a new one or bring their own. Please note that if you indicate you would like to purchase or bring your own device, but change your mind, you can still access the library laptop option at any time.

## 1. Purchase

- Parents may purchase a laptop from our preferred supplier 'Learning With Technologies' through an online portal. You are not obligated to purchase from this company.
- The 3 laptops offered meet all the requirements that students will need for school use including options for insurance, warranty (return to base or onsite repairs at school) and accessories.
- Laptop delivery is guaranteed for mid January 2024.
- Laptops purchased through this site are sent directly to the school ready for students to start the school
  year.

## 2. Borrow and return a laptop from the library each day

- The student receives the same computer each day which they collect from the library before school and return to the library after school between 3:30 and 3:45. This may not be a new computer.
- Installation of all appropriate software. No other software or music allowed.
- Access to school IT support staff for routine maintenance and problem solving.
- Warranty is arranged by the school.
- Insurance for accidental breakage organised by school (Family pays any excess).

## 3. Bring your own laptop (BYOD)

#### Please contact the IT Manager prior to making this choice

Students bring their own laptop to school Laptops must be:

- Minimum Screen Size of 13.3"
- Core I3 Gen 10 Processor
- 8GB RAM
- Operating System Windows Professional 10 64Bit
- 256GB SSD Hard drive

- 7 Hour Battery
- 1 RJ45 Ethernet Port
- 802.11a/b/g/n wireless LAN
- Be less than 4 years old

In addition to the above please note that:

- IT staff can offer support but cannot help with hardware or virus issues.
- Repairs and warranty issues will need to be arranged and completed by the family (3 year onsite is required)
- Laptops are required to be insured by the family.
- Once a BYOD device no longer fills the required specifications or is more than 4 years old it will no longer be able to be used.

## **Apple Mac devices**

Families can elect to use an Apple / Mac device at school but please be aware that there are limitations to their use within the college. These include:

- Limited printing options.
- Not all software used at Ararat College is supported for MAC users.
- Very limited MAC ICT support from Ararat College.

We strongly recommend that families contact our I.T. Manager before making a decision to use a MAC device, especially if you are looking to purchase one for school use.

## Do I need to purchase a new Laptop?

Families who have purchased laptops in the past will need to check to see if their device needs updating.

Generally laptops will have a life span of 3 to 4 years maximum, however sometimes they may need to be replaced before this due to damage or other technical issues making repair unviable. In these instances parents are welcome to purchase a new device or take up the library loan or BYOD option instead.

- Once ordered your laptop will be delivered to Ararat College and all necessary software will be installed.
- Students collect their device from the college at the start of the school year.
- Orders need to be made by THURSDAY 30<sup>th</sup> NOVEMBER 2023.

## **CASIO ClassPad Calculators**

Students in Year 11 and 12 who have selected General Maths or Maths Methods will need to have access to a Casio ClassPad calculator. Ararat College has ClassPad calculators available to loan students for these subjects, but many students elect to purchase their own.

Parents should note that this calculator, whilst expensive, has a long life expectancy as it has the capacity to have software upgrades and should last for several years. This is important, especially if parents wish to pass this calculator on to siblings or on sell at the end of their students schooling.
